Red Cards for 2008

It's been decided to keep the status quo on the criteria for Red Card holders until the next Annual General Meeting of Bowls SA. Changes to the existing criteria can only be done after Districts recommendations and approval of Council.

New Red Cards for scholars who joined the program can be ordered from the Secretary of Development, Elize Opperman.

We would also like to update our database on the Development program and Districts are requested to send us their latest name lists. These lists must reach the Development Standing Committee Secretary before the 31st March 2008.

Red Cards Holders

The card itself carries no rights or obligations. All it says is that the holder of the card is involved in the development of the sport as a learner/scholar. The card is to be issued to any junior person who is playing in social type games and is not a member of a club. Once they start taking part in club games and competitions they automatically become liable to become full members of the club and as such are responsible to Bowls South Africa for the payment of their full subscriptions. Districts and clubs are free to make their own arrangements regarding their District and Club fees and levies
