World Record Attempt

- An Official Bowls Game
- Deliver as many Bowls within an hour
- As many players on green playing within an hour
- Bowls and Jack Delivered will be included in Total
- Participants Information Recorded – Validation
- Delivered Bowls/Jack recorded and Verified
- Information Sheets and Summary Sheets Supplied
- Contact on Day with HQ and with District

Green & Format of Play

- Green to be strung for seven (7) rinks
- 4 metre spot on both ends to marked
- Start of play 12:00 and End of Play at 13:00
- A Bell should be rung at the START and END of the game
- A Pre Warning Bell should be rung 5 Min prior to the start
- A Pre Warning Bell should be rung 5 Min prior to the end
- Each Rink to have one record keeper (bowls/jack delivered)
- Skips record game on scorecards
- Last end Independent Record Keeper to count no. of bowls
- Each Green to have one appointed Record Keeper

Format of Play

- Four (4) players per team each playing two (2) bowls
- Mat to be placed on 4 metre mark
- Jack to be delivered and placed on opposite 4 metre mark
- Third to stay with front rank - assisting non bowlers / speeding up game
- Last bell, no further delivery of Bowls, delivered bowls to be left on green
- Bowls in uncompleted end must be totaled by independent record keeper
- Both skips to sign scorecard and record of bowls delivered
- Scorecards and record of Bowls delivered to be handed to Green Record Keeper/ Technical Official for Validation
- Independent Record Keeper / Technical Official to hand signed cards to the Club Event Co-ordinator / Office

Cost and Extra's

- A donation of **R20.00** per participant to be collected
- Nationally Accumulated funds will be given to a CHARITY/IES
- Local Businesses and sponsors may assist
- Media coverage, especially for the World Record Attempt
- Provide Music, Food Stalls, etc
- Have alternate entertainment i.e. kids jumping castle
- Revenue generated from sales of material supplied for/by the National Event Organising Committee to be paid over
- Advertising material provided to be returned
- All other income derived will be for the club funds
