## Survey of Disabled bowlers in South Africa

**Includes Physically Disabled (PD), Visually Impaired (VI), Deaf, Hard of Hearing (DH) and Transplant (TP) players**

Persons qualifying to play **Physically Disabled** Bowls are those with a permanent disability varying from, amputees, cerebral palsied, polio, spinal cord or head injuries, and progressive disorders such as multiple sclerosis.

**Visually Impaired** bowlers are those ranging from "totally blind" to those varying degrees of visual impairment.

The categories for **Deaf, Hard of Hearing and Transplant** bowlers still need to be finalised, but will most likely follow the national conventions.
