We advise that arrangements are currently being concluded through the Tournament Committee to host the above event at the Wanderers Club in Johannesburg over the week-end of 12/13 September 2015. This event represents the finals and Districts are invited to enter their respective qualifying teams. These qualifiers are the District winners and runners – up in the local Spec-Savers Pro 10 Pairs.

Districts are requested to take the following into account.

- The closing date for entries being on or before **31 July 2015**.
