2. **Players on Loan:** Districts may 'loan' players from other Districts. Refer to Bowls SA Circular 54/2010
3. **Reserves:** Only one reserve per team will be allowed.
4. **No of Teams:** There are no restrictions as to the number of teams being entered per district.
5. **Managers:** It is expected that a Manager, and where considered necessary an Assistant Manager, will accompany the teams.
6. **Bowls SA Membership Data Base:** Bowls SA Membership numbers of each player MUST appear on the entry form otherwise the entry of the team will not be accepted.

NOTICE OF A MANAGERS' MEETING TO BE HELD ON 03 APRIL 2017 AT 17h00 AT HEADQUARTERS

POINTS FOR DISCUSSION

- 1. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES**
Opening ceremonies will be held at **08h30** at venues. Parades to line up in alphabetical order.
Closing ceremony: All the U30 and U20/U15 players must attend the finals and take part in the closing ceremony parade at headquarters
- 2. ACCOMMODATION:** To find suitable accommodation please consult with the Tournament Secretary.
- 3. MEALS:** All meals for the account of the players.
- 4. ALCOHOL:** The consumption of alcohol by any player under the age of 18 years is strictly prohibited. Any player under 18 years old in breach of this ruling will immediately be disqualified
- 5. SMOKING:** No smoking on greens or within 2 metres radius of the green, club house or any other demarcated areas. Managers to refrain from smoking within the 2 metres radius of the green as well.
- 6. DISTRICT FLAGS.** These will be provided by Bowls SA.
- 7. MIXED TEAMS.** Any combination of male and female players may be used for the composition of a team of four players. Teams may be of single gender or mixed gender.
- 8. GAME FORMAT:** The Tournament shall be played on a league basis in sets of seven ends each over 21 ends with all teams in the same section playing each other. The winners of each section shall play one another in the final for gold and silver. There shall be no bronze play-off as both the sectional runners-up will be awarded bronze medals.

Bowls South Africa reserves the right to alter the format depending on the number of entries received.

9. SCORING AND SECTION WINNERS.

One point is awarded to the team that wins a set and two points are awarded for the winning team for the game. In the event of a set, game or match being drawn, the relative points will be shared.

Total number of points available per match – five.

Should play be abandoned for any reason the scoring will be as follows:

SETS One point for the winner of each completed set. The points for incomplete sets are to be shared.

GAME Once two sets (14 ends) have been completed, the team with the greatest number of shots, based on completed ends, will be the winner. If less than two sets have been completed, the points are shared equally.

10. CONDITIONS OF PLAY: Discuss any clarification needed in connection with “Conditions of Play” as set out in the rules of the tournament.

11. SWOPPING OF PLAYERS: No swopping of players between teams allowed.

12. RESERVES: One reserve per district allowed.

13. DAILY MANAGERS’ MEETINGS: Managers’ meetings will be held daily after lunch
