- 1. Player Eligibility:** All players both male and female who may turn 15 years of age during the year of the event.
- 2. Mixed Teams:** Any single gender or combination of male and female players may be used for the composition of a team of four players.
- 3. Team Entries:** Each District affiliated to Bowls South Africa is invited to enter **individual teams of four and one reserve**. Districts may submit as many team entries as required with the understanding that the additional entries for their C or D teams can only be confirmed after the closing date. If more than one team is entered the entry form must clearly indicate whether it is the **A, B, etc**, team and cannot be changed once the draw has been done.
- 4. Players on Loan:** Districts may **'loan'** players from other Districts. Refer to Bowls SA Circular 54/2010
- 5. Team Managers:** Each team must be accompanied by a Manager.
- 6. Indemnity Forms:** Managers to keep completed indemnity forms handy at tournament. Allergies of any of the players, or any illnesses or chronic medical conditions or any other matters for notification must be noted on the indemnity form.
- 7. Dietary requirements:** If your team members have any specific dietary requirements, please describe fully below:
- 8. Conditions of Entry:** The District and Manager must agree to the conditions of entry as set out on the entry form and on page 2 and must ensure that good control over their players is exercised at all times.



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TOURNAMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Financial Support:** We are pleased to advise that should a District confirm a team entry in the tournament a grant of R5000 will accrue to the District. This applies for one team only regardless whether the District enters either the U/15 or U20 event or both only, although Districts may enter additional teams for their own account. Districts may use the grant for either private or hostel accommodation. The amount of R5000 will be paid into the district's account. A further amount of R 1000.00 shall be paid to the District for every team entered where at least 50% of the team is made up of players from previously disadvantaged communities.
2. **Accommodation and Transport:** Please note that all arrangements regarding accommodation and transport will be the responsibility of each District.)
3. **Meals:** Lunches, teas and suppers will be provided free of charge for all U15 players, *reserves and the registered managers during the tournament. (*One reserve per district allowed.)
4. **Bowls SA Participation Certificates** will be made out strictly *as per the names appearing on the official entry form. Any name changes or spelling mistakes after the final declaration of teams will be for the account of the District.*
5. **Managers:** The Manager is the guardian of the players during the tournament. The Manager must therefore ensure that the players do not wonder off unattended after the day's play and to ensure that they are under the care of the Manager at all times.
6. **Bowls SA Membership Data Base:** U15 players must insert their Bowls SA Membership numbers on the entry form otherwise the entry of the team will not be accepted.
7. **Alcohol:** The consumption of alcohol by any U15 player is strictly forbidden for the duration of the tournament, whether on the bowling club premises or anywhere else. Any player in breach of this ruling will be disqualified immediately.
8. **Smoking:** No smoking on greens or within 2 meters radius of the green, club house or any other demarcated areas.
9. **Daily Supper:** All players and Managers are obliged to stay for supper unless prior arrangements are made at registration. Should a team fail to have supper without prior notice the district will be billed at R30 per person.
10. **Entertainment** The entertainment programme will commence after the day's play and cease at supper time. No entertainment will be provided after supper.
