With the bowling arm, you don't bend or play with the smallest bowl on the market due to arthritis or no power in your hands to control the bowl, all you need to do is pick the bowl up with the arm, make sure the bias is correct and deliver the bowl or the white to the desired position. We found that the bowl size 4H gives best results, the swing momentum determines the distance that you would like the bowl to travel, full ends is no problem, I can prove that.

The bowling arm is for Right and Left handed bowlers in four standard sizes.

Short 60cm for bowlers up to 1.55m tall
Medium 65cm for bowlers up to 1.85m tall
Long 70cm for bowlers over 1.85m tall
Wheelchair 43cm

The medium arm is the most commonly use

BOWLS SA: CIRCULAR 11/2019, DOMESTIC REGULATIONS

We advise a change to our Domestic Regulations as determined by Law 41.8 as published in the "Laws of the Sport of Bowls" Third Edition.

41.8 As all disabilities are not defined in law 41.8 any player, who requires the use of an artificial device to deliver the jack or bowl, may do so without prior approval from the Controlling Body.
