KEY FOCUS AREAS

The High Performance Sport Science, Technical and Research Working Group will advise the SASCOC Board, through the High Performance Commission, on the following matters:

1. National policy on scientific, technological and research support systems;
2. National sports science, technology and research strategy for high performance sport in line with the National Sport and Recreation Plan (NSRP);
3. Scientific and technological assessment/ intervention and research protocols and tools;
4. Scientific, technological and research support to identified National Federations;
5. Latest developments in the field of sports science, technology and research;
6. Monitoring, evaluation and co-ordination of sports science, technology and research programs delivered by service providers;
7. Criteria for accreditation of service providers;

8. Identify and support implementation of applied sports science and technology research that could enhance sports development and performances;
9. Establish and maintain international co-operation with identified countries and institutions;
10. Collaborate with the HP Coaches and National Federations on the preparation of athletes for major events;
11. Advise national, provincial and district academies of sport, as part of a national development pathway for athletes and coaches.

- iii. Para Sport Classifiers who have an International classification license and 5 years' experience at classifying at National and International events.
