NATIONAL PBA RANKING – TOP 100

Dear District Representatives,

On behalf of Bowls South Africa and in partnership with PBA South Africa, I would like to provide an update regarding the National PBA Ranking currently visible on the Fairtree BowlsMaster App.

As many of you know, this ranking system recently launched and represents a significant step forward in creating a unified view of competitive performance across all districts. The current Top 100 ranking displayed on the app has been created using the data received to date from participating districts.

I wish to emphasise that the ranking is not yet final. The system remains in a development phase, and the accuracy of the national standings is entirely dependent on the completeness of the data provided by each district. Several districts have not yet submitted their full results, which means that a number of top-performing players may currently be missing from the list. It is essential that all districts submit their outstanding data as soon as possible to ensure that deserving players are not excluded.

The Top 100 for the National PBA Ranking will be finalised by the end of January 2026, with the data that we have received, verified, and processed.

In addition, I am pleased to share that we in the process of developing a BSA National Log, which will go live next year. This log will use the same dataset, making it even more important that districts maintain consistent and timely submission of their results.

I ask for your cooperation in ensuring that your district's information is submitted promptly, accurately, and in full. This initiative is an important step in elevating bowls in South Africa, and its success relies on the collective participation of all districts.
