PASSING OF JANNIE DE BEER

1. It is with great sadness that we advise the passing of **Jannie de Beer** on 7 May 2026.
2. Jannie was awarded her Protea Colours in 1992.
3. Internationally, Jannie won the Gold Medal in the Triples and a Silver Medal in the Fours at the 1996 World Championships in Leamington Spa, England. The following year she won the Fours Gold Medal at the Atlantic Rim Bowls Championship in Llandrindod Wells, Wales.
4. Domestically Jannie built a remarkable bowls record, non-less than winning the National Women's Fours titles in 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 whilst being a member at Centurion Bowling Club.
5. We are grateful for the contribution Jannie made to our sport and express our condolences to her two daughters, many grandchildren and great grandchildren, as well as her bowling friends.
