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BOWLS SA: USE OF “LOTTO” DEVELOPMENT BOWLS IN COMPETITIONS AND TOURNAMENTS

1. The Bowls SA Executive Committee has received a number of enquiries regarding the use of the “Lotto” Development Bowls that were **previously** distributed to Districts and Clubs for development purposes. For clarity, there are two variants of these bowls: one bearing the “Lotto” insignia together with a World Bowls stamp, and another bearing the “Lotto” insignia and the wording “Bowls SA Development Bowl” but not bearing a World Bowls stamp.

2. Development bowls bearing the **“Lotto” insignia and the World Bowls stamp** (as depicted in Picture 1) may be used by scholars in competitions and tournaments at all levels, excluding Bowls SA Masters events, subject always to the applicable Conditions of Play and the authority of the relevant controlling body. These bowls were purchased by Bowls SA, using the then Lotto grant, and distributed to Districts and Clubs specifically for development purposes. They are to be made available to eligible players on loan by the Club until such time as the players are able to acquire their own bowls. They must not be treated as having been gifted or sold to any individual player.

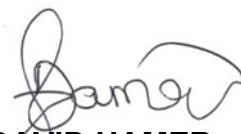

3. Development bowls bearing the “**Lotto**” insignia and the wording “**Bowls SA Development Bowl**” but not bearing a **World Bowls** stamp (as depicted in Picture 2) may not be used in any official competition or tournament. These bowls were purchased by Bowls SA, using the then Lotto grant, and distributed to Districts and Clubs solely for development purposes. Accordingly, they may only be used for training, coaching, social bowls, business leagues and similar non-official development activities. Any person in possession of such bowls should return them to the relevant Club so that they may be used for their intended development purpose.
